Motion by Hessedence to accept Truax's absents. Seconded by Fetters. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Reviewed April Police reports, Sgt. Balash informed council officers have received 4 body cameras through a grant and have installed laptops in all patrol carts.

Discussed installation of reserved parking for Honey Market, referred to zoning inspector for review.

Discussed farmer's market, turn out was fair given bad weather.

Discussed dog ordinances with Robert Cyperski. Council was informed of state law that supersedes local ordinance. Determined no further action was needed by council at this time.

Motion by Hessedence to purchase safety equipment at estimate of \$600.00 Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Motion by Fetters to exit executive session. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.
