Motion to suspend/pass/emergency O-5-17-09 award 2017 paving bid with all alternates to Milhoan Asphalt for low bid cost of \$193,840.00 by Hessedence. Seconded by Black. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Motion to purchase 1000 business cards and magnets with village information for cost estimate of \$250.00 by Stelluto. Seconded by Feters. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. motion carried.

Legal update: Mr.Cyperski will issue several letters for property/zoning violations as request from Mangieris.

Village update: Guard rail replacement will be in September.

Bob Easterday requested clarification on zoning requirement to keep grass mowed at less than 8". Mangeris will check into. Requested copy of current employee handbook, clerk will provide.
