Legal update: Cyperski explain changes in new property maintenance ordinance. After significant feedback from council and those in attendance bob will make modifications prior to second reading for council to consider. Bob also stated sewer department will not allow 2 line on one parcel so combing community part parcels will not be an option for sewer easement.
