Motion to excuse Truax and Fetters by Black. Seconded by Stelluto. Roll call 4 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Police reports, were informed about theft at Dollar General and several traffic stops ending in drug charges.

Reviewed Fire & EMS reports, reviewed. Christmas party will be held 12/1/18 @ Pike Grange Let Dan know if you will be attending. Will ask Chief Adams to attend December meeting to explain MARCS radio system upgrade to council.

Motion to provide \$5000.00 for MARCS radio system upgrade for fire department by Stelluto. Seconded by Russell. Roll call 4 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.
