

MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST SPARTA, COUNTY OF STARK AND STATE OF OHIO HELD IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING ON April 15th2019.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. Mayor Stropki led Council and visitors in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Police reports reviewed, Officer Balash presented reports and updated council on recent issues.

Reviewed Fire & EMS reports, reviewed. Fetters informed council the fire siren has been repaired.

Pool board: Working on spring fundraisers and pool opening.

Motion to approve pool start up expenses of \$2500.00 estimate for pool startup by Stelluto. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

BPA report: no report

Mr. Render expressed concerns over property located at 9373 Maple. Garbage, old pool, and dogs loose. Mike is aware and owner already issued warning.

Mr. McDade expressed concerns over Prostitution and drugs operating out of a rental unit on McKinley. Officer Balash was aware and working on the case. Investigation ongoing. Expressed concerns over last years paving of McKinley, believes pavement should have been ground down first, has caused issues with his and others drive way approaches.

Motion to suspend/pass/emergency R-4-19-03 2019 Paving Bid Advertisement by Fetters. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Motion to pass/suspend/emergency O-3-19-02 Parking by Russell. Seconded by Fetters. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Legal update: Cyperski reviewed property clean up status, several properties have been greatly improved. Working on conversion of Willow property to village.

Village update: Jeff informed council he will need about 5 ton of road patch, requested paint striper, will complete culvert replacement with assistance from Pike township in the fall.

Motion to purchase Graco paint striper at cost not to exceed \$6900.00 by Stelluto. Seconded by Black. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. motion carried.

Zoning update: Mike is continuing to work with property owners on cleanup. Issued 5 day clean up notice to property on Walnut, will contact owner of 2185 Pine about deteriorating garage roof for removal.

Motion to approve property clean up budget of \$5000.00 by Stelluto. Seconded by Black. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. motion carried. Cost will be charged back to property owners.

Mangiers informed council he is working on property maintenance issues on the following properties; 9373 Maple, 2001 Pine, 9382 Main, 2185 Pine, 9500 block of Chestnut, Garfield (old Broad's Garage), and a property on Clearview. Several have already been cleaned up by owners. Reported that Williams plans to build on the cleared lot on Main.

Motion to adjourn by Fetters. Seconded by Russell. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. Meeting adjourned 8:19pm.
