Motion to excuse Fetters by Stelluto. Seconded by Black. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. motion carried.

Police reports reviewed, Officer Balash presented reports and updated council on recent issues.

Reviewed Fire & EMS reports, reviewed.

Pool board: Reviewed meeting minutes and work update. Working on additional fund raisers.

Motion to accept resignation from park board of Kim Moore by Stelluto. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion Carried

BPA report: no report. Council acknowledged and commended Robert Easterday for his 25 plus years of service to the BPA, he will be deeply missed.

Motion to appoint Jeff Render to fill vacant BPA term expiring 12/31/19 by Stelluto. Seconded by Russell. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Mr. Render expressed concerns over property located at 9373 Maple. Mike has confirmed that trash construction bag is owned by property

owner and will have removed. And will work with health dept if needed. Owner was already issued warning.

Motion to suspend/pass/emergency O-4-19-05 Concealed Carry by Russell. Seconded by Stellutto. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Motion to suspend/pass/emergency O-5-19-05 Summer worker pay rate by Black. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Motion to accept 2019 paving bid from Milhoan Asphalt for \$63,385.00 by Russell. Seconded by Black. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Legal update: Cyperski was informed Willow property is at Land Bank and should be ready to transfer to Village in late June. Several parties have contacted him with interest in the property.

Village update: Painted pool bottom, plumbing repairs, basketball court needs repairs, mowing and will begin curb painting and striping.

Zoning update: Mike reviewed property clean up status on various properties. He has been very busy enforcing new ordinance. Pine Street property required 8 hours of clean up time with contractors. He has met with several property owners this month and they have improved their property as requested.

Motion to exit executive session by Stelluto. Seconded by Truax. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. motion carried.

Motion to increase zoning inspector salary to \$100.00 per month and \$20.00 per hour for clean-up site management and required court time by Stelluto. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried. Clerk will prepare resolution and fund transfers for June meeting.
