Motion to excuse Truax by Fetters. Seconded by Black. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. motion carried.

Motion to accept resignation from Jackie Truax by Stelluto. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Motion to appoint Jenna Hessedence effective 10/1/19 for vacant council seat by Stelluto. Seconded by Muir. Roll call 5 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Police reports reviewed, Officer Balash presented reports and updated council on recent issues. Discussed recent warrant arrests and explained some traffic patrol hours on SR800 are funded by a grant.

Reviewed Fire & EMS reports, reviewed.

Pool board: Discussed possibility of leaving gates open through the daytime for park grounds use, discussed possible repairs and improvements before next season. Fall bingo 10/18/19.

Village update: Catch basin on Pine will need repaired, Pike cleanup dates will be reduced to 2 per year, traffic light was hit by lightning and blew fuse.
