Motion to provide landfill passes for property clean up as determined by zoning inspector by Stelluto. Seconded by Russell. Roll call 6 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Legal update: Cautioned that Ohio Courts are pushing dates on enforcement actions. Resolved issue with suspended license on old traffic court violations, waiting for BMV confirmation from Columbus

Village update: no Pike Township spring cleanup this year. Added 1 catch basin repair to Joe Little at cost of \$250.00.

Zoning update: Mike posted notices for 16 cars to be removed and 13 properties to be cleaned up.
